As an organization, Caribe aspires to see all its students attend college after high school. However, we have found that many of our youngsters are held back from attending college because of their SAT scores.

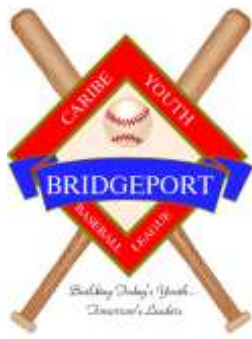

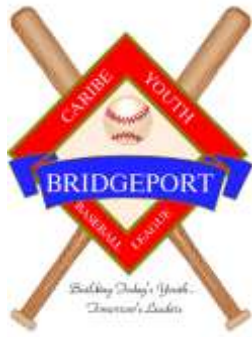
Students (and families) must be able to commit to the following:
